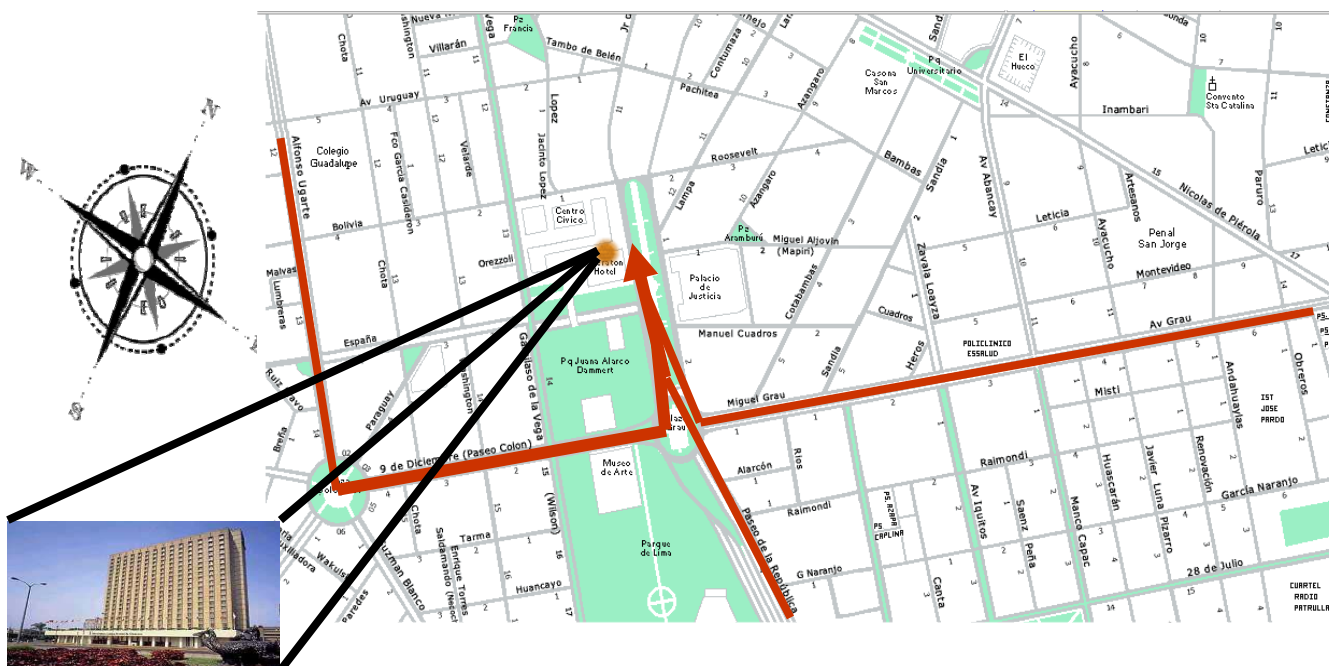

Lima is the capital of Peru, with a population of over seven million inhabitants (just under a third of the country's total population). The climate is mild and cool throughout the year, due to its proximity to the sea and the absence of rain. In September the average daily temperature in Lima is around 15° to 19°C (59° - 66° F) and it is very humid.

OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

International Airport

Jorge Chávez International Airport is located in the [Constitutional Province of Callao](#), 10 km from the centre of [Lima](#). It is the main airport in [Peru](#), in which most of the country's international and national flights are concentrated.

No Smoking policy

Smoking is forbidden in all public areas throughout the country (Law N° 25357). Smokers are recommended to locate special public zones in which smoking is permitted.

Currency and Exchange Rate

The national currency is the *Nuevo Sol* (S/).

The exchange rate floats freely, according to market demand. At present (July 2009), the rate is around: S/ 3.02 per one US dollar.

Taxes and Tariffs

Goods acquired in Peru are subject to a 19% general sales tax. Services in general (restaurants, hotels, etc.) carry an additional 10% tax.

The airport tax at Jorge Chávez International Airport is USD 30.25. This tax is payable at the airport prior to departure and may be paid in US dollars or in the national currency (*nuevo sol*).

Electricity

Electric current 220 volt/60 cycles AC is the standard in most of Peru. Most hotels also have special 110-volt outlets.

Medical Care

There will be permanent medical services available at the Sheraton Lima Hotel. In addition, the organizers have contracted an ambulance and medical personnel from the Ministry of Health to be available during the conference.

AH1N1 Influenza Prevention

There is a Prevention Against AH1N1 Influenza Booth at Jorge Chávez International Airport, which all passengers arriving in Peru showing any symptoms of respiratory distress will be required to visit. As a precautionary measure only, they will undergo a medical check-up before leaving the airport. Any person who is found to be suffering from influenza symptoms will receive immediate medical care at the nearest hospital.

SAFETY

As in any cosmopolitan city, there are dangers which may be avoided if prudent precautions are taken and participants are urged to abide by the following recommendations:

1. Look after your personal effects. Any valuable objects (money, jewels, documents, etc.), should be left in the hotel's safe deposit box.
2. Do not leave the hotel alone and do not carry any visible valuable objects.
3. If taking a taxi, request the hotel's reception for information on reliable companies. It is not advisable to take just any available car.
4. If using a laptop, camera, video camera or any other equipment during the Conference, keep it by you at all times. Do not leave equipment on your seat or entrust it to third parties.
